Questions to Consider

1. From our initial reading of the book of James so far... what are the marks of a mature follower of Jesus?
2. When you look at yourself, what do you see? (think not only about your exterior appearance, but more about your internal appearance)
3. How have you spiritually changed over the last year / five years?
4. Look at vs. 29. Does that characterise you? (Quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to become "angry" / opinionated)
 - a. How does this impact our ability to hear the Word of God?
 - b. What aspect do we need to change the most?
5. What does it mean to "humbly accept the word planted in you"? (vs. 21) How do we do this in increasing measure?
6. How can we ensure we "do what it says"? (vs. 22)
 - a. How many times do we hear the Word of God and not allow it to change us?
 - b. How can we be more intentional about aligning our lives to the Word of God?
